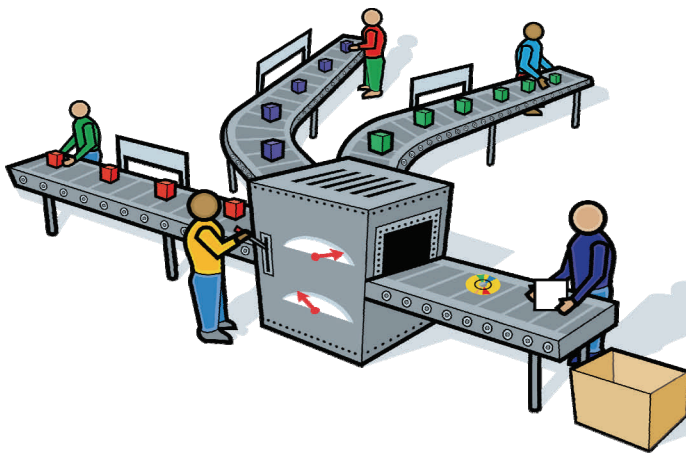

Employment opportunities are offered in 3 venues to meet the needs, wishes, and potential of the participant:

- Production and manufacturing facilities located in Daytona Beach and Palm Coast where those not ready for community employment are taught assembly, janitorial, manufacturing skills, etc.
- Work contracts are awarded by local manufacturers for specific jobs and by RESPECT of Florida, a State set-aside program which enables certain products to be assembled by disabled persons and sold to State government entities.
- The third venue is our Supported Employment program that uses job coaches to screen, job match, interview, and find employment for disabled individuals in competitive jobs in the community. They also provide on-site training assistance and follow-up case management services to both the employer and employee.

We operate an in-house entrepreneurial enterprise that bids for and administers specific contracts to provide custodial and grounds keeping services to a variety of customers. Some of these customers are part of the Florida Department of Transportation and include weigh stations and rest areas awarded through the Respect of Florida set-aside program.
