May 2013 will go down in SMA's history as the year Project WARM found a home! After many years of searching for a permanent home for the youngest members of our community, we not only found the ideal location, we were able to double the number of parenting women in treatment from 16 to 32.

The Foundation reached its goal of \$1 Million in the endowment fund. This enabled us to begin making allocations from the revenue generated to SMABH's programs and departments in the form of "mini grants" of \$2,500 each. Thirteen grants totaling \$42,983.83 was allocated.

Our Dinner & Gala honored NASCAR's youngest DAYTONA 500 winner—Trevor Bayne. In its 15th year we broke all previous revenue records thanks to all of you supporting this, our signature event. It's the talk of the town for our fabulous raffle items and thrilling live auction!
